

transacting other business. Meetings shall be open to all active members. Notice of these meetings shall be issued by the secretary and shall be mailed to the last recorded address of each member at least ten days before the time appointed for the meeting. A majority of the active members of this association present at any meeting shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of business.

ARTICLE VIII: OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES.

A. ELECTIVE OFFICERS. The elective officers of this association shall be: a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer. In addition there shall be four other board members elected. All such officers and board members shall be elected at meetings of the active members of the association for terms to be provided by the vote of such active members.

B. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. This association shall have an executive committee comprised of all the officers and board of directors of the association.

C. STANDING COMMITTEES. This association shall have such standing committees as are necessary to achieve its purposes.- such committees to be established by vote of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES.

These articles may be amended or repealed in whole or part by a majority vote at any duly organized meeting of this association.

ARTICLE X: BY-LAWS.

By-laws will be hereafter adopted. Such by-laws may be amended or repealed in whole or in part, in the manner provided therein, and amendments to the by-laws shall be binding on all members; , including those who have voted against them.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION - "SIDEWINDERS ON TWO" AMATEUR RADIO CLUB

TO Further the common purposes the members agree to organize under these articles of association.

ARTICLE I : NAME

The name of this association shall be "SIDE WINDERS ON TWO"- (SWOT)

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office at this association shall be at 1704 Glenn Drive, Fort Worth TX 76131, County of Tarrant, State of Texas. The association may have other offices as from time to time may be designated by the members or executive committee.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES

The purposes of this association shall be to promote the amateur radio spectrum known as the Two Meter Band, especially in the mode known as Single Side Band; to conduct activities toward that purpose? establishment of radio nets (on the air meetings); and promote the education of radio amateurs in the use of the bands and in the study of radio propagation and to do anything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of this purpose. This shall be a non-profit organization and no members shall use it for personal gain.

ARTICLE IV: POWERS

In furtherance of the purposes described above, but not in limitation thereof, the association shall have the power to collect and disseminate statistics and other information; to engage in funding and fund raising activities; to conduct promotion activities, including advertising and publicity, and to engage in such organizational activities as are necessary in achieving the purposes of the association.

ARTICLE V: MEMBERSHIP

Anyone holding a valid Federal Communications Commission amateur radio license interested in promotion of single sideband activities in the two meter amateur radio band is eligible to become a full active member of this association, with full voting and other privileges? provided such person is qualified under the rules such as the executive committee shall provide. Each active member shall be entitled to one vote in the affairs of the association. Proxy voting is permitted.

ARTICLE VI: DUES

The annual dues required for membership in the association shall be determined by the vote of the board members? on recommendation of the executive committee. Dues shall be varied from year to year? but the dues shall be the same for all full active members.
